Besides, teachers can design tests, games, and activities for students in a short period of time. Users are no longer using the traditional methods of searching such as books or dictionary; hence they can apply the up-to-date technology in searching for essential information which is helpful for their job. Teachers can use ChatGPT as a tool to encourage students to develop critical and creative thinking skills.
